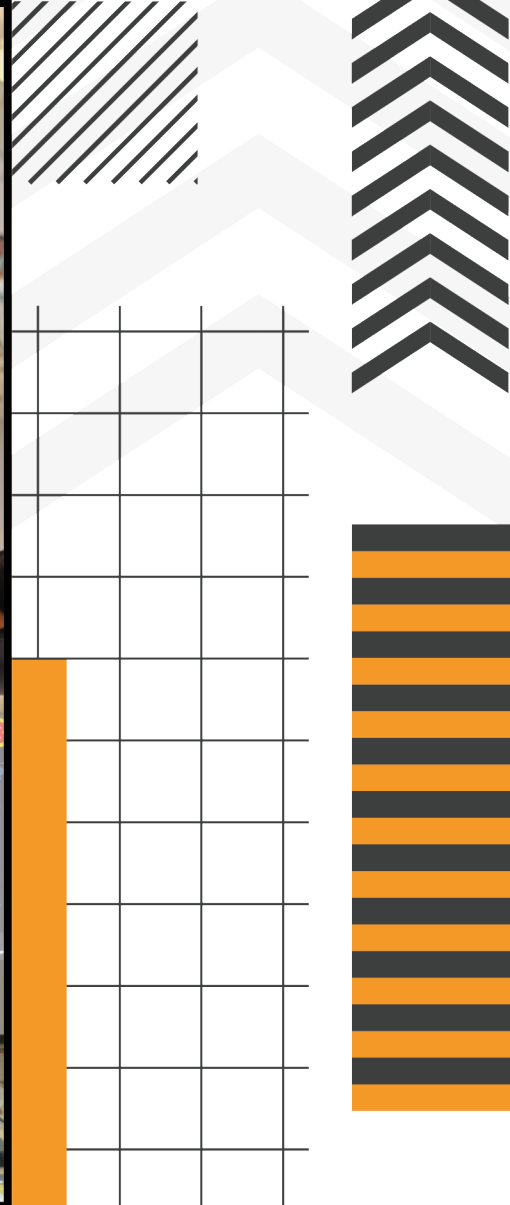

Turkish International Academy Against Smuggling and Organized Crime (**TADOC**), founded under the General Directorate of Security Department of Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime, is an academy that offers basic and specialized in-service training at the regional, national and international scale in the field of “**Fight against Smuggling, Financial and Organized Crime and Threats of National Security, Money Laundering, and Financing of Terrorism**”.



TADOC was established in **Ankara** on **26 June 2000** under the agreement signed between **Türkiye** and the **United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC)** in order to:

- ✓ carry out Turkey's ongoing national and international efforts to fight against the production, use and smuggling of illegal substances to the field of training,
- ✓ fight against organized crime in the light of scientific data,
- ✓ provide a favorable basis for building, sustaining and improving cooperation among the countries in our region and among the countries with which Türkiye has bilateral security cooperation,
- ✓ implement the project of establishing an international law enforcement academy with a view to contributing to the strengthening of international cooperation by building a social network between law enforcement personnel that attend TADOC trainings and the personnel of General Directorate of Security.



TADOC'S MISSION IS TO:

- ✓ meet the need for training in the field of **anti-smuggling** and **organized crime** for law enforcement departments,
- ✓ meet the need for qualified personnel,
- ✓ carry out scientific research in the field of **“Fight against Smuggling, Financial Crimes, Money Laundering, and Organized Crime”** by developing new methods,
- ✓ provide support to law enforcement departments, through modern training techniques,

NATIONAL TRAINING UNIT

In the National Training Unit, TADOC provides basic and specialized training at the **theoretical level** for law enforcement personnel employed in the **Gendarmerie, Coast Guard** and **Customs** as well as in the Department of Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime of TNP (Turkish National Police).



TACTICAL TRAINING UNIT

In the Tactical Training Unit, TADOC provides **basic** and **specialized training** at the **operational level** for the personnel of the Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime Department of TNP and the **provincial units** of Anti-smuggling and Organized Crime in order to improve their performance.



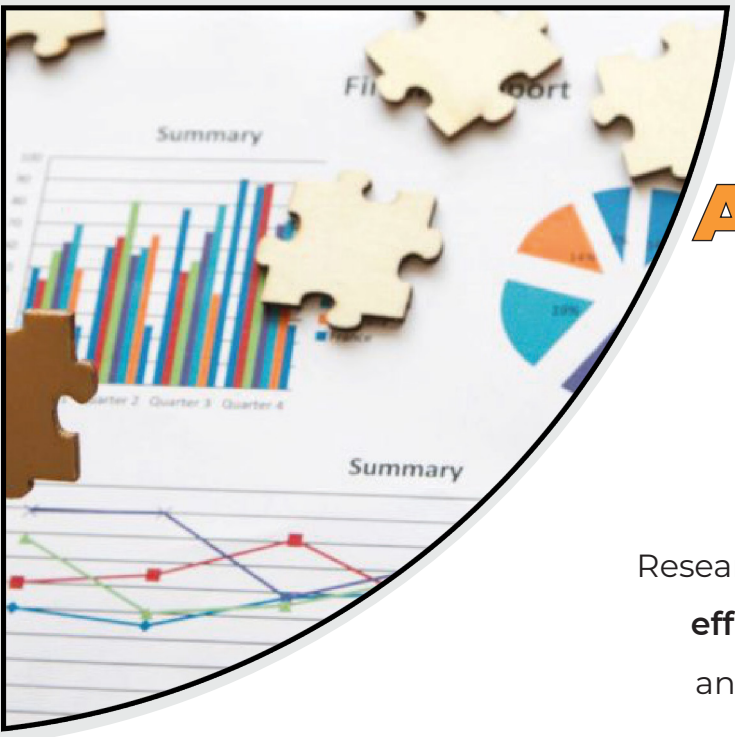
INTERNATIONAL TRAINING UNIT

In the International Training Unit, TADOC offers training programs for **foreign law enforcement personnel** in cooperation with **allied countries** with which Türkiye concluded **bilateral security agreements** and **international organizations**.



UNIT FOR ANALYSIS NEEDS AND RESEARCH CENTERS

The Unit for Training Needs Analysis and Research Centers evaluates the **effectiveness** and **efficiency of training programs**, and monitors and coordinates **training needs of other units** and **academic research**.



TADOC TRAINING CENTER



✓ TADOC Training Center is located in the campus of the Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime Department at **Necatibey Cad. No: 108, Ankara.**



✓ The classrooms and other facilities based at **three locations** of the campus are equipped with modern educational and technical infrastructure.



✓ TADOC Training Center has **three classrooms, two meeting halls and one computer-assisted classroom**, each with a capacity ranging from **22 to 35 persons.**

✓ **12 and iBase analysis systems** are available in the computer-assisted classroom for use in distance/online training as well as face-to-face training programs.



✓ In the Tactical Training Unit, there are **one classroom, one operation house and one interrogation room** used in training on how to enter a person's residence, how to search a private residence for judicial purposes, and interrogation and questioning techniques.



✓ There are **Airsoft guns** and a **shooting simulation platform** used in the TADOC operation house.

✓ In addition to facilities in the TADOC Training Center, **one meeting hall** (with a capacity of **25 people**), **one workshop hall** (with a capacity of **38 people**) and **one conference hall** (with a capacity of **287 people**) in the Department of Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime are used to host national and international conferences.



✓ In addition to modern education facilities, TADOC has **social facilities** that provide trainees with productive ways to spend their free time.



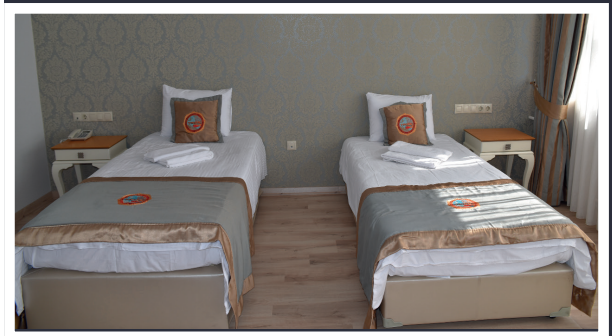
✓ The Training Center houses **cafeterias** to be used by trainees in break times.



✓ There is a **full-fledged sports hall** in the TADOC Training Center.

✓ There is also **sauna** and **fin bath** in TADOC

✓ The TADOC Training Center has a **guesthouse** (with the quality of a **4-star hotel** and with a total capacity of **20 rooms** and **40 guests**) for trainees.



✓ Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, which has had a large-scale impact worldwide and hindered international mobility, TADOC decided to establish an **Online Training Center** in 2020 and proceeded to ensure the continuity of participants' access to TADOC training programs.





NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMS

TADOC offers **basic** and **specialized** training in order to “**contribute to the development of professional knowledge and expertise**” of personnel employed in the central and provincial units of Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime. Furthermore, law enforcement personnel employed in the **Gendarmerie, Coast Guard and Customs Enforcement** can attend training programs held by TADOC.

It is a **prerequisite** for newly recruited personnel of Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime Units to attend the **Basic Training on Fight against Smuggling and Organized Crime** held by TADOC.

The aim of specialized training is to equip trainees with knowledge and skills that they require to fulfill special duties and tasks in Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime units. Continuous efforts have been exerted to update and improve these training programs in line with the results of needs analysis performed regularly.

TADOC training programs are **trainee-centered**, adopt **adult learning principles**, and encourage trainees to take active part in the learning process.

INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMS

TADOC, updating and enriching its training content regularly with input from subject-matter experts in line with the needs of countries in the region, offers training programs for law enforcement personnel not only in Türkiye but also abroad **in cooperation with nations with which Türkiye signed a bilateral security agreement and several national and international organizations.**

Since its establishment in **2000**, TADOC has organized training programs in which law enforcement personnel from **101 countries** participated in cooperation with international organizations such as **United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE), Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO), and Conference on Interaction and Confidence-Building Measures Asia (CICA).**

TADOC does not have a prespecified annual academic calendar. The schedule of training programs is determined in line with the **demands of countries and organizations.** Requests for training must be addressed to **Turkish Ministry of the Interior Advisors, Embassies and Consulates in many countries, ue@egm.gov.tr** (International Relations Department of TNP), or **tadoc@egm.gov.tr** (TADOC).

Training programs are held either in the **TADOC Training Center** or in **demanding countries** by **TADOC Mobile Training Teams.**

TADOC trainers include specialized personnel with plenty of field experience employed in the central and provincial departments of Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime, judges and public prosecutors employed in local, regional and superior courts, academics in higher-education institutions, and financial crime specialists.

TADOC's international training portfolio includes **20 basic and specialized training programs** in the field of **"Fight against Smuggling, Financial Crimes, Money Laundering, and Organized Crime"**.



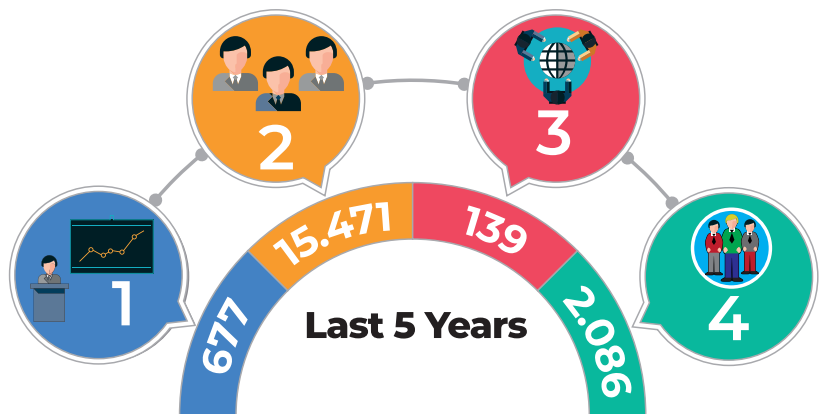
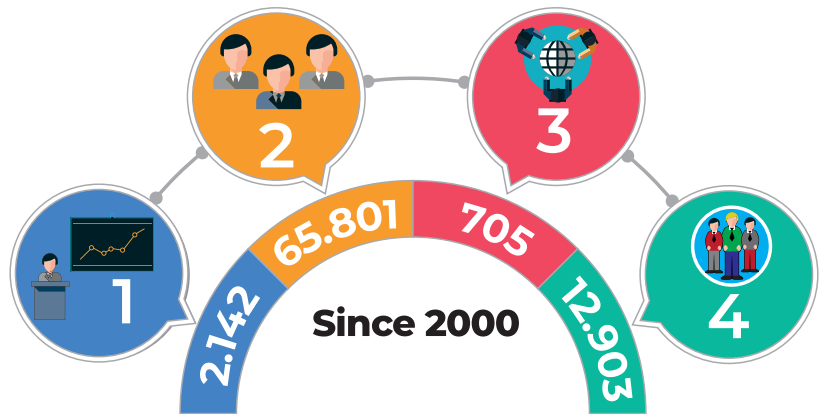
TADOC TRAINING MAP

Number of Participants in International Trainings 4





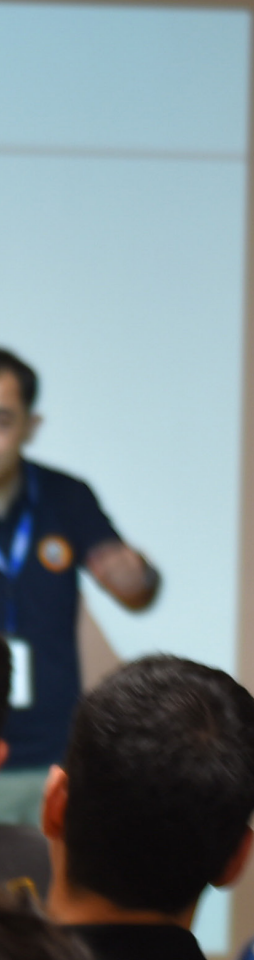

Objectives



Aim of Training

Adopting the principles of student-centered learning, this program aims to equip participants with the knowledge, skills and attitudes to enable them to design and deliver effective, efficient and engaging learning sessions.



Participant Profile

This program is designed for law enforcement trainers or candidate trainers of any expertise area in relation to combating smuggling and organized crime. Participants must be trainers, program planners or capacity builders with relevant experience in law enforcement field.

The participants make a presentation about a specific topic that is determined by themselves during the training and they are evaluated by the trainer immediately after the presentation.

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Explain the changing role of a trainer from an instructor to a facilitator and develop their facilitative teaching skills to maximize learning for their audiences.
- ✓ Learn and explain the major theories of learning and their application in practical field.
- ✓ Demonstrate through the process of planning, design, preparation and presentation the necessary skills and methods required to organize and present effective and successful training instructions.
- ✓ Describe and successfully apply appropriate learning aids and teaching methods that are responsive to adult learning principles.
- ✓ Build effective course plans and deliver interactive and informative training sessions utilizing the adult learning principles and student-centered learning.
- ✓ Apply effective communication techniques as a trainer and effectively manage the classroom.
- ✓ Self-assess their performance in order to be able to develop their teaching skills continuously.

SURVEILLANCE TECHNIQUES

Objectives



Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Determine the surveillance methods in compliance with the conditions.
- ✓ Determine the fixed observation points with reference to specific criteria.
- ✓ Describe the principles and practices of successful foot and vehicle surveillance.
- ✓ Learn the key points they should consider following the observation.
- ✓ Determine and accept an emergency exit plan for unexpected situations.
- ✓ Record the surveillance results and maintain the integrity of records to protect the chain of evidence.
- ✓ Recognize the situations where it is necessary to end surveillance and intervene to apprehend the target(s) under surveillance.

Aim of Training



The aim of this course is to equip law enforcement officers of anti-narcotics and/or organized crime units with the necessary knowledge, skills and abilities to effectively, competently and ethically carry out covert surveillance operations.

Participant Profile



This training is designed for lower or mid-ranking law enforcement officers who are or will fight against narcotics and organized crimes.

The participants will have a valid driving license and drive vehicles competently in addition to their tracking task in operational units.

CRIME INTELLIGENCE ANALYSIS

Aim of Training

The aim of this course is to equip the law enforcement officers with the required knowledge, technics and skills in order to obtain definite and meaningful intelligence data such as strategic assessments, tactic assessments, target profiles and trouble profiles and data analysis in relation to the crime.



Participant Profile

This training is designated for low and mid-ranking law enforcement officers to be assigned or will be assigned in their respective organizations for crime and intelligence analysis related to the movements of the assets, finance and organizations having tendencies to develop criminal activities.

Participants must have basic computer keyboard skills and knowledge of Windows Operating Systems.

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Apply appropriate techniques for the collection and storage of raw data during their analytical tasks.
- ✓ Define principles of information collection and explain intelligence cycle.
- ✓ Recognize and differentiate between strategic and tactical intelligence.
- ✓ Question and use the databases efficiently as they need during their analytical tasks.
- ✓ Evaluate and analyze data and produce intelligence products using various techniques and instruments including software programs.
- ✓ Form, manage and question the databases.
- ✓ Make telephone data analysis to understand the roles of individuals within an organization.
- ✓ Analysis of the raw data they collect with efficient method and techniques.
- ✓ Present the raw and analyzed data to be obtained by using various techniques, form tables describing the relations between the components related with the crime, visually and crime-related components.

OPERATIONAL POLICE TACTICS

Objectives



Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Plan and manage the operational tasks.
- ✓ Carry their fired arms safely and use in tactic shootings.
- ✓ Apply the tactical communication principles.
- ✓ Plan and prepare against raids and be aware of alternatives.
- ✓ Understand the importance of the collection of accessible intelligence before an operation is started.
- ✓ Blockade the target buildings.
- ✓ Protect captured suspects or witnesses against offences.
- ✓ Protect themselves against possible offences from the suspect during the capture of the suspects and provide the handcuffing, search and transportation of the suspects safely.
- ✓ Apply the first aid principles against fired arm wounds.

Aim of Training



This training program aims to equip the participants from Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime Units with the required knowledge, experience and behavioral values on successful operational planning, performance and methods.

Participant Profile



This training program is designed for lower-ranked law enforcement officers and/or police officers who carry out or will carry out operational duties in Anti-Smuggling and Organized Crime Units.

ANTI-CORRUPTION TRAINING

Aim of Training

This program aims to provide participants with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively and competently conduct corruption investigations.



Participant Profile

This program is designed for junior, mid-level, and senior law enforcement officers who have responsibilities for enforcement and investigation of corruption offences.

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Learn about international conventions and anti-corruption initiatives by international organizations.
- ✓ Achieve a better understanding of what constitutes corruption and who may be liable for corruption.
- ✓ Identify official corruption and explain the types, patterns, and indicators of corruption.
- ✓ Learn and explain direct and indirect bribe payments, common schemes for bribing public officials, and techniques for disguising bribery of officials.
- ✓ Identify the sources of information and intelligence in corruption cases.
- ✓ Apply appropriate investigative techniques, including electronic and physical surveillance, use of informants, and undercover investigators, and make accurate decisions on when and where to use such techniques during the whole investigation process.
- ✓ Properly gather relevant documents and electronic evidence in corruption cases.
- ✓ Learn and apply interview and interrogation techniques for corruption offenders.

UNDERCOVER TRAINING

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Understand and apply much better the covered personnel techniques to be used in operations against smuggling and organized crimes.
- ✓ Explain the preliminary conditions and basic procedures to be required to undertaking an undercover operation.
- ✓ Indicate the talents which should be owned by covered personnel in his/her behaviors and attitudes.
- ✓ Apply the intelligence and evidence collection techniques successfully and safely.
- ✓ Cross-control the gathered information.

Aim of Training



The aim of this program is to equip law enforcement officers with the necessary information, skills, attitudes and behaviours in order to enable them to carry out their covert operations in accordance with the legislation in force.

Participant Profile



This program is prepared for the law enforcement officers whose countries have the convenient infrastructure in their legal regulations to use undercover and take or will take place in covered operations of the units fighting against smuggling and organized crimes. The participants should;

- ✓ Be a volunteer to be assigned for covered operations.
- ✓ Have the ability to assess the conditions.
- ✓ Have the talent to play different roles as covered personnel.
- ✓ Have a good memory, self-confident, creative and reasonable.

USE OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANT

Aim of Training

The aim of this program is to equip experienced personnel with the necessary knowledge and skills in the field of obtaining human intelligence information from the methods and actions of criminal organizations in the fight against crime; including the recruitment and management of informants, and conducting operations and investigations based on the information obtained.



Participant Profile

This training program is designed for law enforcement officers who are or will be involved in operations related to smuggling, organized, financial crimes, proceeds of crime, and whose countries have a legal framework suitable for using informants.

- ✓ Participants should possess professional knowledge and experience that allows them to benefit from informant information.
- ✓ They should have the ability to conduct situation assessments.
- ✓ Good communication skills, self-confidence, and professional experience are essential attributes for participants.

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Better understand and apply informant management in operations related to smuggling, organized crime, financial crimes, and proceeds of crime.
- ✓ Demonstrate legal and behavioral approaches accurately and safely in informant recruitment, general informant characteristics, obtaining information from informants, and informant management.
- ✓ Apply intelligence and informant information-gathering techniques directly and securely.
- ✓ Conduct control over the obtained information.

INVESTIGATIVE INTERVIEW AND STATEMENT ANALYSIS

1 Week / 5 Working Days

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Take accurate, comprehensive and structured statements in compliance with the organizational standards and judicial rules.
- ✓ Define the factors which may affect people to remember the events periodically and fully during the investigations and interviews with the victims, witnesses and suspects,
- ✓ Adopt appropriate interviewing methods for cooperative or uncooperative interviewees.
- ✓ Be aware of factors that may affect victims, suspects and witnesses during taking a detailed and correct statement from those people for important organized crime investigations and interviews.
- ✓ Consider the characteristic features like age, gender, cultural and ethnical background which may vary during the investigations.
- ✓ Know the significance of the searches, preparations and plans before the interrogation and taking statement.
- ✓ Demonstrate appropriate sensitivity and consideration for human rights during an interrogation.

Aim of Training



The aim of this course is to equip participating law enforcement officers with the required knowledge and skills to perform interviews and analyze the statement of the suspects, witnesses and victims pursuant to the definite evidence collection and management rules. and principles of justice, ethic and human rights.

Participant Profile



This training program is designated for low and mid-ranking law enforcement officers who have or will have responsibilities for interviewing and taking statements of victims, witnesses and suspects in criminal investigations.

OPEN SOURCE INTELLIGENCE IN CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS

Aim of Training

This program aims to equip the law enforcement officers with necessary knowledge, technics and skills to analyze the open source and social media related datas and get the intelligence data through open source that can support their criminal investigations.



Participant Profile

This program is designed for low, mid and high level law enforcement officers who work or will work in crime intelligence analysis units or operational and technical units in their organizations and know and use Windows Operating Systems.

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Learn the types of open sources.
- ✓ Get the data through the open source.
- ✓ Get information about how to find the owner of websites or accounts which constitutes a crime.
- ✓ Find out the copies' or similars' of obtained pictures whether they are available or not on internet.
- ✓ Understand and apply the basic concepts about Social Media Analysis.
- ✓ Obtain the personal datas from Social Media.
- ✓ Have knowledge about IP-Domain, e-mail, darkweb, fake account and deceptive applications.
- ✓ Effectively use search engines and find the websites that constitutes anti-smuggling and organized crime factors.
- ✓ Learn the types of programs that are used in open source intelligence in the world.

RISK ANALYSIS AND SEARCH TECHNIQUES

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Determine the situations correctly if the search is required.
- ✓ Apply the professional, comprehensive and systematic search techniques on persons, vehicles, buildings, work places, goods and furniture.
- ✓ Define the profiles that is related to which person, vehicle, good and property is carrying the risk.
- ✓ Plan, manage and control the searches with reference to approaching the campuses and entrance techniques to search for a vehicle, person, good and property, and inform before and after the search.
- ✓ Learn the common hiding methods and show the vacancies that can be used as stash.
- ✓ Explain the risks that may pose a threat to human health and safety and measures that eliminate or minimize these threats.
- ✓ Record and maintain the evidence in compliance with related procedures following the search.

Aim of Training



The aim of this course is to equip the participants with the required information, skills and attitudes for safe and efficient search of individuals, vehicles, buildings, workplaces, goods and furniture to obtain evidence in all kinds of anti-smuggling operations and investigations.

Participant Profile



This training program is designed for mid and high-ranking and constable law enforcement officers whose primary responsibility is anti-smuggling and who are working in Anti-Smuggling units.

RISK ANALYSIS IN SMUGGLING CRIMES AND SEARCH TECHNIQUES AT AIRPORTS

Aim of Training

This program aims to provide participants with the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities to effectively and competently combat smuggling at airports.



Participant Profile

This program is designed for law enforcement officers who work at anti-smuggling units at airports.

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- ✓ Learn and explain the destinations and the routes of smuggling through airports,
- ✓ Make risk analyses and profiling on flights, passengers, cargo, and luggage,
- ✓ Learn about suspicious passenger behaviors and make passenger profiling from the entrance gate to the exit gate,
- ✓ Effectively interview and interrogate suspicious passengers,
- ✓ Investigate travel documents,
- ✓ Learn common drug concealing methods,
- ✓ Apply professional, comprehensive, and systematic search techniques on persons, luggage, goods and belongings, and cargo,
- ✓ Learn how to best utilize sniffer dogs at airports,
- ✓ Recognize the importance of "airport crime" in smuggling at airports.

Aim of Training

- ✓ Use the internet effectively in crime investigations and they will have knowledge about the police applications of current technological developments.
